WHY WE DID IT

Eid al-Adha is celebrated by Muslims all around the world to commemorate the completion of Hajj, the annual pilgrimage to Mecca. It is observed through the sacrificial slaughter of animals, known as Qurbani, to honor the willingness of Prophet Ibrahim (AS) to sacrifice his son, Ismail (AS). Penny Appeal USA is committed to making the Islamic duty of Qurbani accessible and beneficial for everyone involved. Muslims around the world live below the poverty line, struggling to provide necessities such as food for their families.

Many of the recipients of our Qurbani distributions are refugee families who have been forced to flee from their homes to escape conflict. Many refugees struggle to find work so for these families, Qurbani means that they can enjoy their Eid al-Adha meal without worrying about how they will pay for it.
